

The Secret Number Game

Materials:

- Numerals from 1 to 10 on small slips of paper in a bag, bowl or bucket
- At least 10 counters such as pebbles, pennies, beans, large beads, etc., in a dish

How to Play:

- The first player chooses a numeral slip from the bag and looks at it secretly, without showing anyone else what it says.
- Player One then puts the paper aside, counts out that many pebbles and places them on the table.
- Player Two counts the pebbles on the table, and “guesses” the other player’s secret number.
- Players then switch roles, with Player Two choosing a numeral slip and counting out that many pebbles so that Player One may “guess” their secret number.
